Meeting of the Temmels Local Council on 8 October 2025

Item 1 – Question time for residents

The lack of visualisation, such as floor plans, for the public during the council meeting was criticised. The Mayor stated that she intends to acquire a larger TV screen for this purpose.

Item 2: Adoption of a Statute for the Use of Municipal Field and Forest Paths

A statute on the use of municipal field and forest paths was unanimously adopted with some amendments.

Item 3: Acceptance and Use of Donations to the Municipality

This agenda item was unanimously removed at the beginning of the meeting.

Item 4: Participation in the Initiative 'Local Communities Take a Stand!'

Although both council groups welcomed the initiative in principle, it was criticised that the draft text did not sufficiently reflect the special concerns of border municipalities. A majority vote therefore rejected participation in the initiative. Instead, the council proposed working with other border municipalities to draft their own position paper.

Item 5: Municipal Consent under §36 of the German Building Code (BauGB)

- **5.1**: The application to renovate and refurbish a single-family house in Temmels was unanimously approved.
- **5.2**: The application to extend a residential building and renew and convert the roof in Temmels was approved by majority vote.

Item 6: Reports and Miscellaneous

The Mayor reported the following:

- The street 'Zur Fels' has been completed as part of the fibre-optic expansion.
- The section 'Auf der Kirth' will follow, depending on the weather, in calendar week 42.
